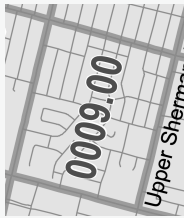

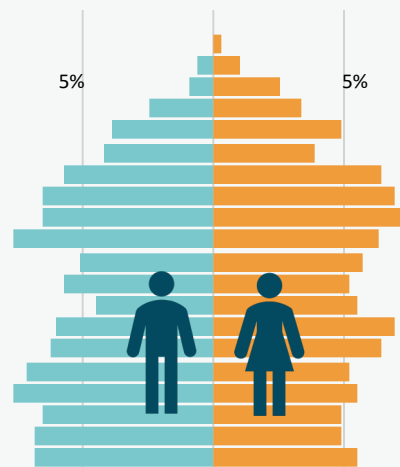

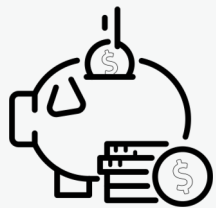
Age Distribution by Gender

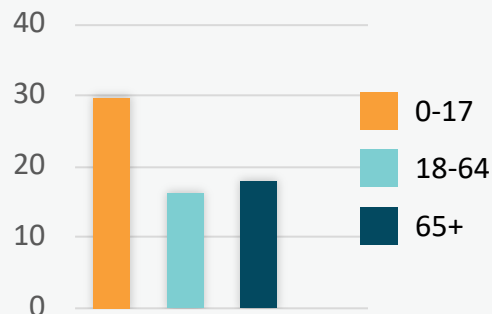

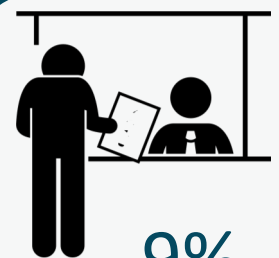
